

TXARANGO BIO

Txarango, hailing from Catalonia, Spain, is one of the region's most popular bands. Their live show melds contemporary and traditional music, Latin rhythms, reggae and dub, performed with virtuosity, energy and force. Txarango's live show is one of musical celebration, captivating all who discover them, from the first song to the encore. Txarango stands out as a key representative of the worldwide phenomenon called the "Barcelona Sound". It is a sound that originates from this cosmopolitan and coastal city, which blends the influences of different cultures under the party philosophy of the Mediterranean region.

After numerous sold out shows, Txarango's 2015 tour year culminated with a special collaboration with the great Cuban pianist and composer, Chucho Valdez, at the Barcelona Jazz Festival. They performed Txarango's songs and a composition they created together especially for the occasion. Since the release of their last album in 2014

"Som Riu", Txarango has played over 120 concerts, spanning 4 continents and over 19 countries, playing for crowds of up to 70,000 people.

Txarango is preparing to bring their "Barcelona Sound" to the festivals and concert halls of North America. They are planning to tour North America in 2017 after the release of their next album in 2016.
